

THE PROJECT

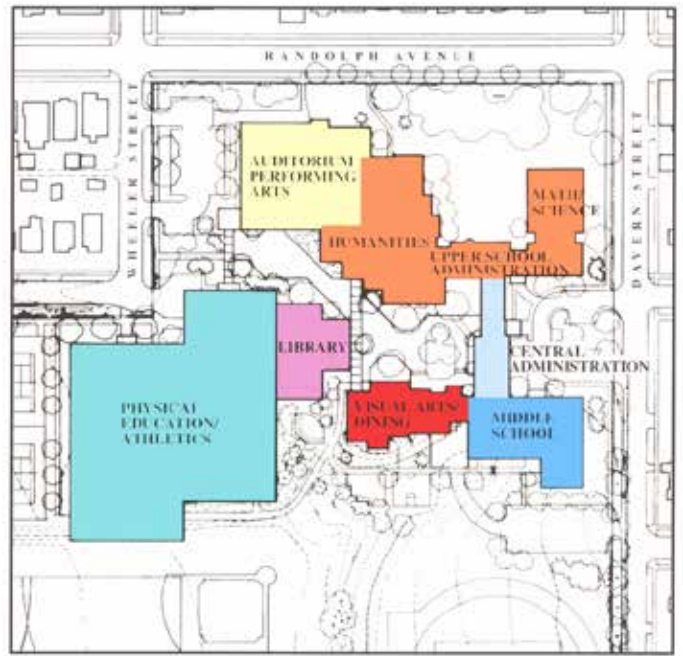
Campus plan studies involved two campus sites for a K-12 enrollment of 925 students.

Focused studies on the Randolph Campus included locating a new middle school suitable for interdisciplinary team teaching, creating a Library Information Center designed to integrate library, media, and computer services; expand indoor athletic facilities; as well as the Performing Arts facility to include a new Auditorium; and renovate space to promote flexible teaching, functional student space, and centralized administrative and faculty space. The focus of the Plan is to create overlapping, yet functionally distinct program areas.
